


We see various types of animals in our locality. Some animals are big and some are small. Some are friendly while others wild. Some may be really beautiful, while some not so good to look at.

TYPES OF ANIMALS

Domestic Animals

Some animals live around us. They are called **domestic animals**. These animals are useful to us.

We give them food to eat and water to drink. We also give them a place to live.





Pet animals

Some animals live in our homes. They are called **pet animals**. We love them. They are our friends. We must take care of them.

Wild Animals

Some animals live in forests. They are called wild animals. We can see them in zoos or national parks. They find their own food. Some of these animals eat grass and plants. Some of these animals eat flesh.



BIRDS

There are various types of birds around us. Most birds fly. All birds have a beak, two wings, two legs and feathers all over their body. They build nests to live and lay their eggs in. Most of the birds eat different kinds of food. Most of bird live on land.



Insects are small animals. They have six legs. Many insects have wings to fly. Some insects do not fly. Some can sting and bite, while others are quite harmless.


