Food And Homes Of Animals

#### FOOD OF ANIMALS

Animals need food to live. They eat different kinds of food.



#### **Plant Eaters**

Some animals like the cow, goat and horse eat only grass and leaves. They are called plant eaters.

#### **Grain Eaters**

Some animals like pigeon, sparrow and parrot eat seeds, fruits and grains. They are called grain eaters.





#### **Insect Eaters**

Some animals like the spider, lizard and chameleon eat insects and worms. They are

called insect eaters.



Some animals like dog, cat and crow eat both plants and flesh of other animals.

#### Flesh Eaters

Some animals like lion, tiger and wolf eat flesh of other animals. They are called flesh eaters.







#### Homes of Animals

Animals also need homes to live in. A home protect them from heat, cold, rain and their enemies. Different animals make different kinds of homes.



A lion lives in a den.



An ant lives in an anthill.



Animals that give us milk are called milch animals.

A rabbit lives in a burrow. A spider spins a web.





Some Animals also live in man-made home.



A cow lives in a shed.



A horse lives in a stable.



A bee lives in a beehive.



A dog lives in a kennel. A bird lives in a nest.



A rat lives in a hole.
