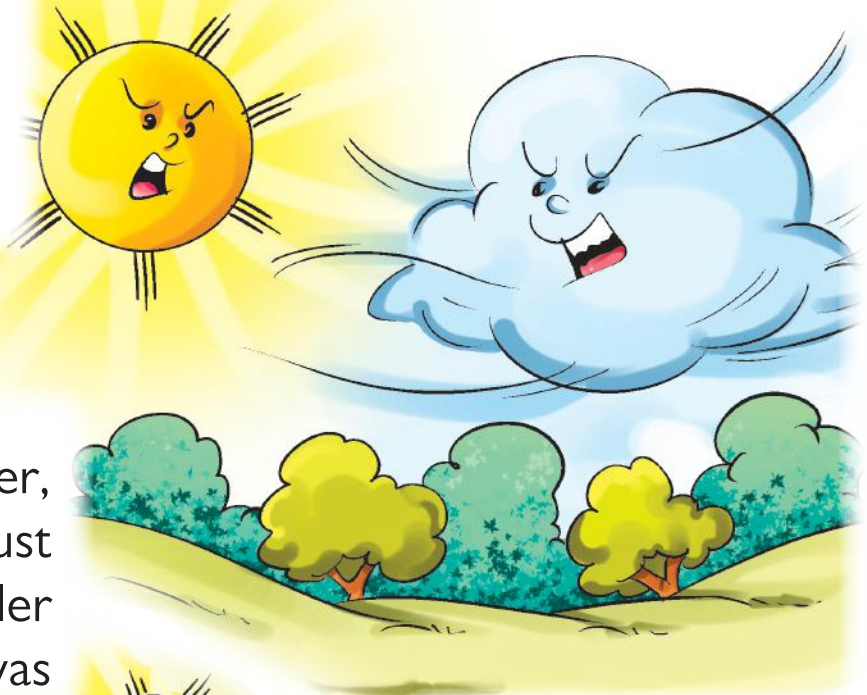


The Sun And The Wind

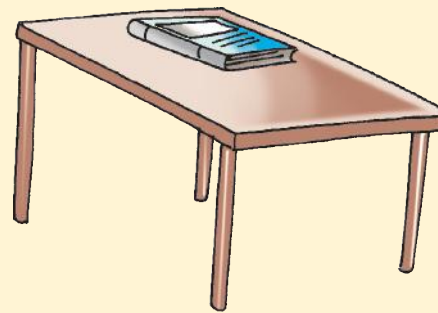
