

We see many things around us.

We see them at home, in our neighbourhood, on the road, in the market and in the school. Some of these things are living and some are non-living things.

Thus, all these things can be divided into two groups :

1. Living Things 2. Non-living Things

1. Living Things

The things which have life in them are called living things, such as, men, women, children, animals and birds etc.



Plants are living things.



2. Non-living Things

The things which do not have life in them are called non-living things. Such as, chair, book, table, TV, radio, fan, bulb, car etc.



FEATURES OF LIVING AND NON-LIVING THINGS

1. All Living Things Breathe

All living things breathe. We breathe air through our nose.





Fish breathe through gills. Plants breathe through small openings in their leaves called stomata.

Non-living things do not breathe. A chair does not breathe.

2. All Living Things Need Food

We need food to live. Food also helps us to stay healthy and grow and keeps our body fit. We eat rice, dal, vegetables, fruits etc. A buffalo eats grass, a lion eats flesh of other animals, while a frog eats insects.







Plants make their food from air, water and sunlight.

Non-living things do not need food.

A chair does not need food.



3. All Living Things Reproduce

All living things produce young ones of their kind. Human being, dog, cat, lion, tiger etc. give birth to young ones.



Some animals lay eggs like hens, snakes, tortoises, birds, lizards and crocodiles. Babies hatch from these eggs.







Plants produce seeds. New plants grow from seeds.

Non-living things do not reproduce.

A table does not give birth to a small table.





4. All Living Things Grow Old and Die A baby grows into a child and then to be an adult. The adult grows old and finally dies. All living things follow a life-cycle. Image: Constraint of the example of th

A small plant grows into a big tree.



5. All Living Things Move

All animals move from one place to another. Even plants show movement. They turn their face towards light.



Non-living things cannot move. A telephone does not move on its own.

Living Things Feel

All living things have some feelings.

Non-living things do not feel.
