IMPORTANCE OF PLANTS

We use many plants and their products for different purposes. We grow useful plants.

Food

Roots

Human beings and animals depend on plants for food.

We eat different parts of plants.

We eat roots of some plants.



STEMS, LEAVES AND FLOWERS

We eat the stems of plants like potato, onion and sugarcane.

We eat the flowers of plants like cauliflower and broccoli.

We eat fruits of some plants.

Seeds

We eat the seeds of some plants. Cereals and pulses are seeds of plants. We get cereals like rice, wheat, maize, bajra, etc., from the plants.



Seeds of some plants are used as pulses like beans, peas, gram, soyabean, etc.



Spices

We get spices from plants. They add taste, colour and aroma (pleasant smell) to our food. Cardamom, coriander, pepper and turmeric are some of the spices.





SOME OTHER PRODUCTS OF PLANTS

Oil

We get oil by crushing the seeds of some plants like sunflower, mustard and groundnut. We mainly use oil to cook food.



Coffee, Tea and Sugar from Plants

We get coffee, tea and sugar from plants.

We get coffee from the coffee beans. We get tea from the leaves of tea plant. We get sugar from sugarcane plant.

Some plants also give us medicines. For example, **tulsi** leaves are used to cure cold. **Cloves** are used to cure toothache.

Wood from Plants

We get wood from trees like teak, sal, walnut, neem, sheesham, etc. Wood is used to make many things like table, chair, pencil, boat and many other things. We also use wood to make doors and windows of houses.

OTHER USES OF PLANTS

Fibre

Plants give us fibre for making cloth, sacks, ropes and mats. Cotton, jute and flax are chief fibres obtained from plants.

Rubber, Gum and Paper from Plants

We get rubber from the latex of the rubber tree. It is used to make tyres and pipes.

We get gum from the juice of the acacia or keekar tree.

We make paper from the bamboo plant.
