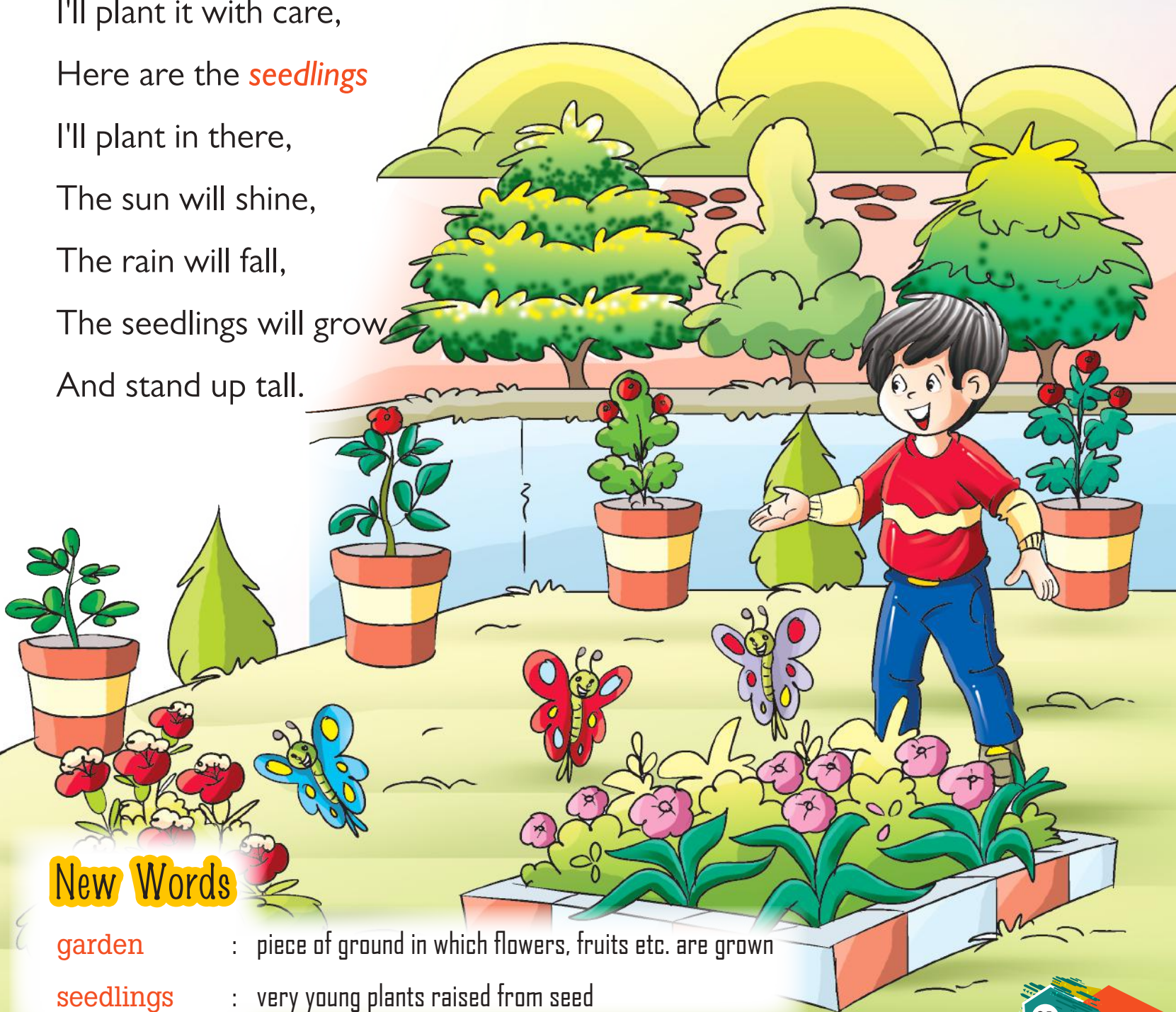


This is my *garden*,
