



Good TOUCH Bad TOUCH

Educating children on appropriate methods of physical contact helps protect everyone from inappropriate behavior.

Everyone has a body, and your body belongs to you. This means no one can touch you unless you say they can. You should always ask for permission before touching someone else. Don't touch them unless they say you can.

Good Touch

It feels good to be hugged and kissed by the people you love. For example:

- When Mommy gives you a hug and kiss after you wake up.
- When Daddy gives you a good-night hug and kiss.
- When Grandma and Grandpa come to visit and everyone gets hugs and kisses.



Bad Touch

Touches that make you feel uncomfortable are usually bad touches. You don't have to keep a secret when someone gives you bad touch. Don't feel that you are bad. Whoever gives you a bad touch is the one who is bad, not you. Your body belongs to you. Nobody should touch you if you don't want to be touched.




Do you know what a bad touch is?

- It is a bad touch if it hurts you.
- It is a bad touch if someone touches you on your body where you don't want to be touched.
- It is a bad touch if the person touches you under your clothing or tickles you under the clothing.
- It is a bad touch if a person touches you in a way that makes you feel uncomfortable.
- It is a bad touch if that touch makes you feel scared and nervous.
- It is a bad touch if a person forces you to touch him or her.
- It is a bad touch if a person asks you not to tell anyone.

What do you do when someone touches you in the wrong way?

- Say no! Tell the person that you don't like it and you don't want to be touched.
- Get away fast! Run away from the person whose touch you don't like. Never stay alone with that person ever again.
- Call for help. You can scream.
- Believe in yourself. You did nothing wrong.
- If someone touches you in the wrong way, tell someone you trust what has happened. Don't let threats scare you into running away or keeping quiet. When a person touches you and asks you to keep it a secret between the two of you, ask yourself, "Does the secret bother me?"
- Don't keep secrets that make you feel uncomfortable. Go to a person you trust—a parent, a relative, a teacher, or your doctor. If the person you go to doesn't believe you, go to someone else you trust until someone believes you and helps you.
- Do everything you can to stay away from the person who is touching you in the wrong way or making you feel uncomfortable. Don't stay alone with a person who touches you in a way that makes you uncomfortable or makes you feel unsafe.




Eklavya's Story

Read this story through pictures.


Long centuries ago, there was a sage Dronacharya who taught archery to the princes of Hastinapur. Among all his students, Arjuna was his favourite.

Architecture of INDIA

The Indian architecture is mostly spiritual in nature. It reflects the lifestyle and history of India. It can be seen in city and town planning (examples-Harappa, Mohenjo-daro and Lothal), temple complexes, observatories, monuments and memorials in various materials from rock to metal. Here are a few examples of different styles of architecture.



Rock-Cut Architecture :

This art was practised around 2,000 year ago.

The example of this kind of architecture is the Chaitya Hall at Karla, Maharashtra. It was built 1st century BC. It was carved out of a single rock. Another example of this architecture is the rock-cut Kailash Temple at Ellora, Maharashtra. It was built in the 6th century AD.

Dravidian Style :

The best example of Dravidian style of architecture is the Rameshwaram Temple at Dhanushkoti, where the famous bridge built by Lord Rama to reach Sir Lanka is still seen with the help of NASA pictures.

The Rameshwaram Temple has two shrines that are enclosed by three concentric walls. It has four gopurams that are built in the best traditions of the 17th century. The 3.6m high pillars of this temple are big blocks of granite that are richly carved.

Solanki Style :

The Tejpala Temple of Mount Abu in Rajasthan is among last monuments built in the Solanki Style. There is a pendant of solid mass of marble in the dome which hangs from the center like crystal drop.

In the main cell, there is an image of Neminatha seated on a couch-shell symbol. There is a floral pattern on its carvings. There are 39 other cells that have the episode from the life of the presiding deity Rishabhadeva or Adinatha. The deity's image is installed in the inner shrine which is open on all the four sides.



Mahayana Architecture :

The best example of this kind of architecture is at Bodhi Gaya. The front of this temple has an impressive image of the preaching Buddha. There are many steps that approach the shrine which is enclosed within a railing. People have to pass through an arched gateway or torana for reaching the shrine. There is an Ashoka Pillar as well in the courtyard.




Pallava Style :

The best example of this kind of architecture is the Mahabalipuram. It has 10 mandapas or halls and 7 monolithic rathas. They resemble the big temple cars in which the images of the deities are taken out in procession. The panels of sculpture enclosed within plasters and mouldings on the interior walls of the Durga and Varah mandapas represent the finest example of the Pallava Style. The architecture of the monolithic rathas is based on the older Buddhists monasteries. They are square or oblong in shape and pyramidal in elevation but the size and the minor details vary.

Modern Architecture :

The best example of this kind of architecture is the Lotus Temple of the Bahai faith at Kalkaji in South Delhi . It is shaped like a half opened lotus flower. This temple is made up of marble, cement, dolomite and sand. The lotus flower signifies purity and peace, a representation of the manifestation of God.



A Blend of Hindu and Muslim Style :

The best example of this kind of architecture is the Golden Temple or Har Mandir Sahib of Amritsar. The main shrine is built in the middle of a tank which never dries up. Guru Arjan Dev initiated the construction of the temple in 1589. His great contemporary Muslim mystic-Mian Mir laid the foundation stone of this temple. Maharaja Ranjit Singh, donated 100 kg of gold to the temple.



Blend of Dravidian, Indo-Sarcenic Oriental and Roman Style :

The Mysore Place is an example of combination of different styles of architecture. It is a 3-storeyed building with a 5-storey tower that was designed by an English architect Henry Irwin. This space was initially built in 1912. There is a kaleidoscope of stained glass and mirrors and beautiful carved in mahogany, floors are made up of white marble and doors are made up of solid silver.
