






PENCIL SHADING






Material Required

You can easily draw difficult objects if a simple template is prepared. Try to follow the same procedure to draw the following objects. Paint the utensils with water colour.












Fruits of various shapes have been drawn below using templates. Try to make them yourself. Draw veins and add colour to make it realistic.














See how beautiful this picture is!






Spray paint art is said to have originated in Mexico City in the early 1980's.

















OIL PASTEL COLOUR


OIL PASTEL COLOUR

CORN BASED ACTIVITY


Step 1: Take a plane sheet and show a pattern of corn as shown.



Rangoli is originated from two words Rang which means colors and Holi which means celebration.











The Ben-day dots painting process, named after Benjamin Day Es similar to pointillism.
