Various grades of pencils such as 2H, HB, 2B, 4B and 6B are used to have different tones of shades.



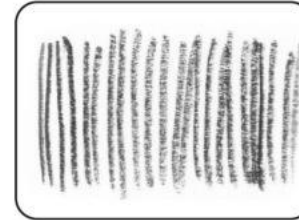

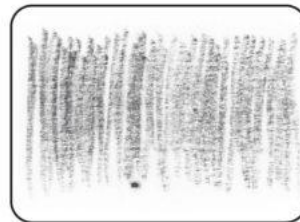
Pencil sketch looks very attractive because of the use of light and dark shades. These shadings can be of different tones.



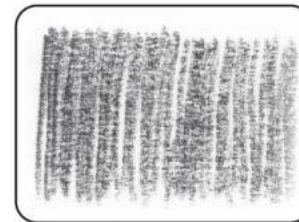

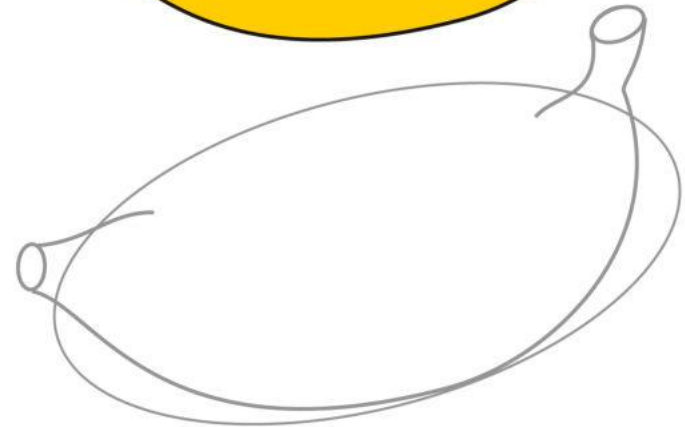
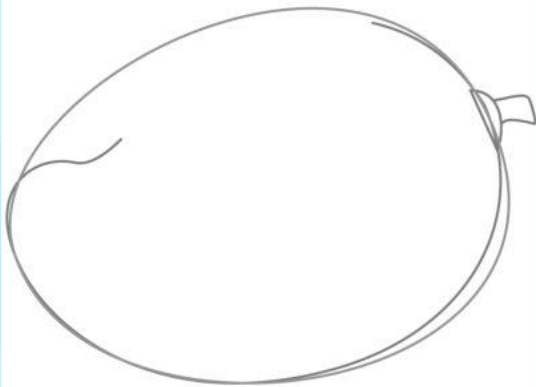
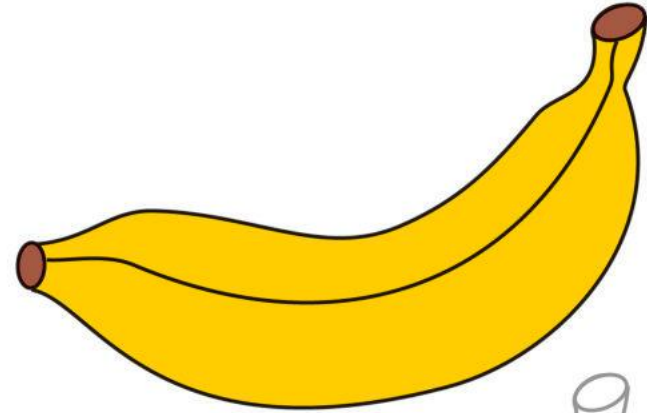
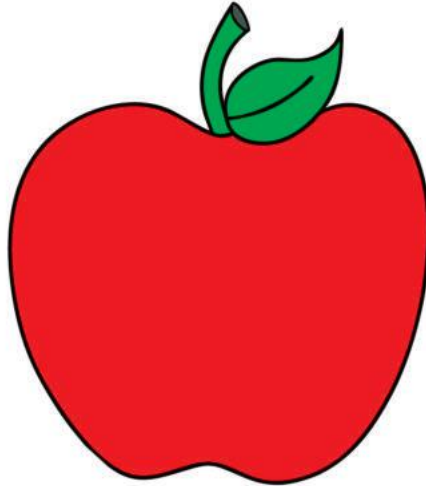
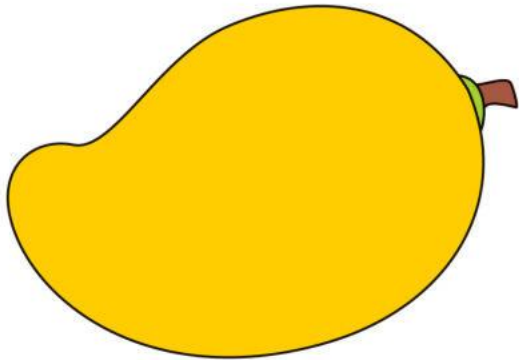




SKETCHING FRUITS

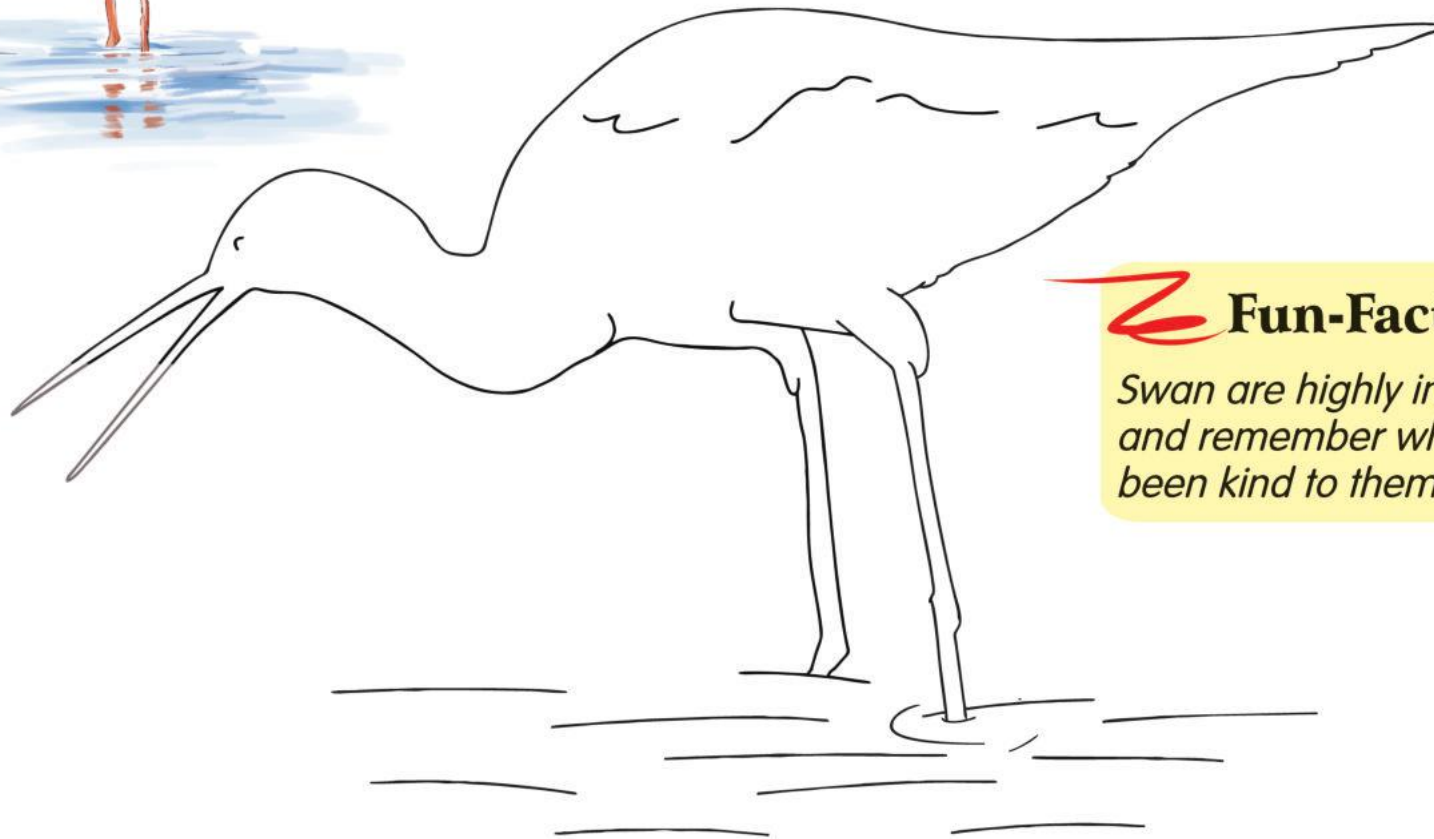

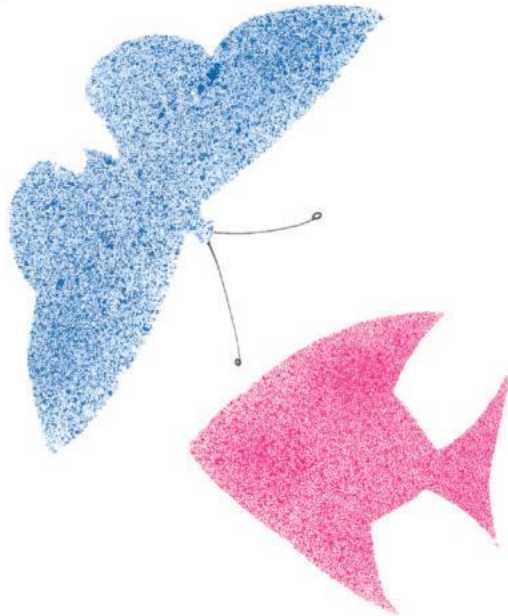
SPRAY TECHNIQUE

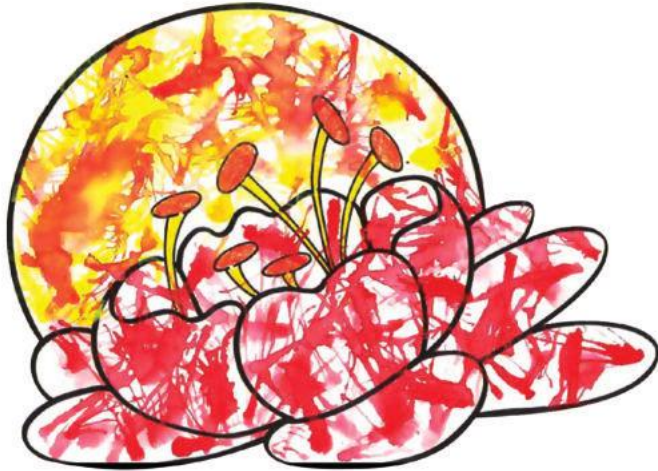




BLOW PAINTING

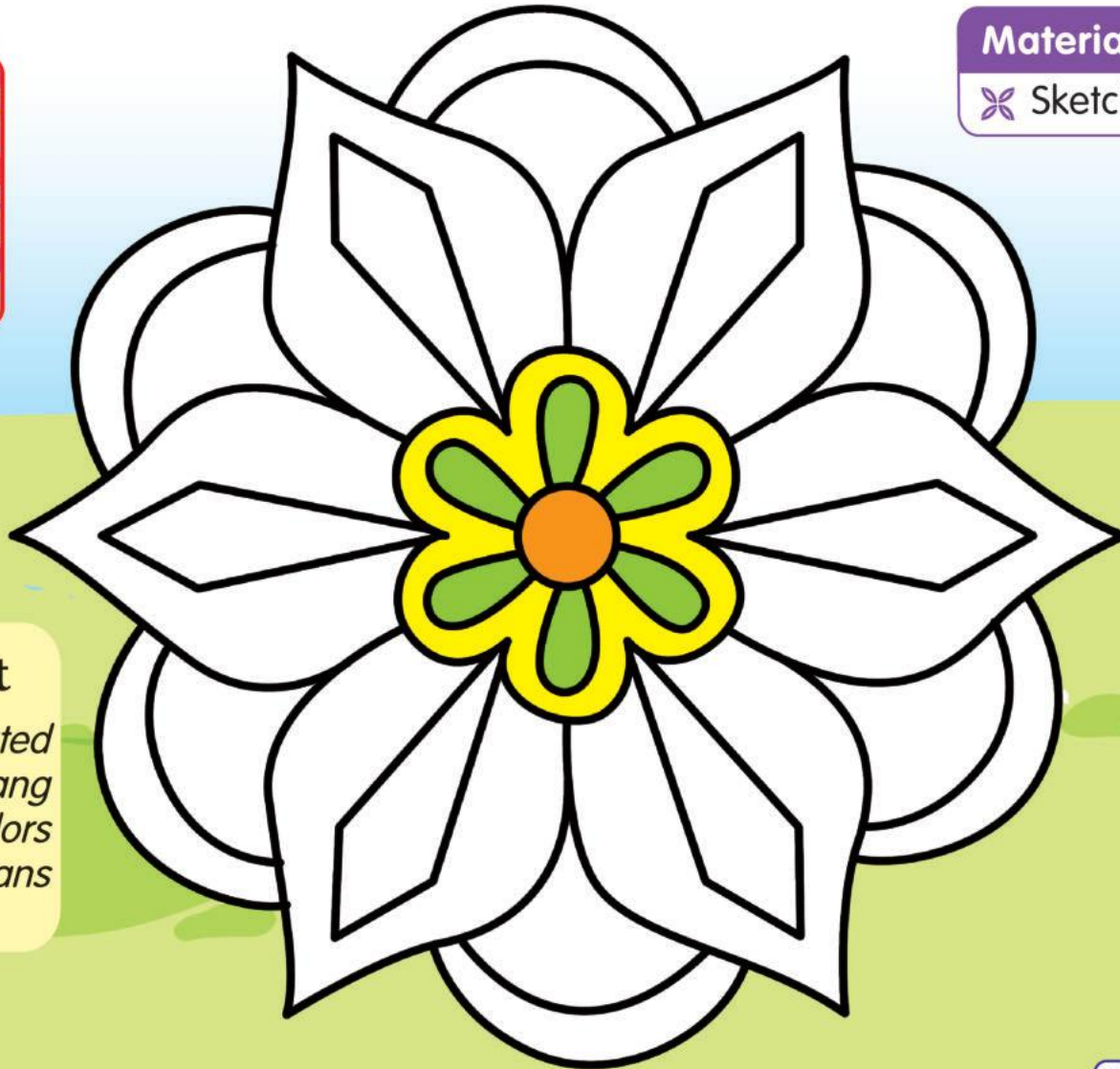

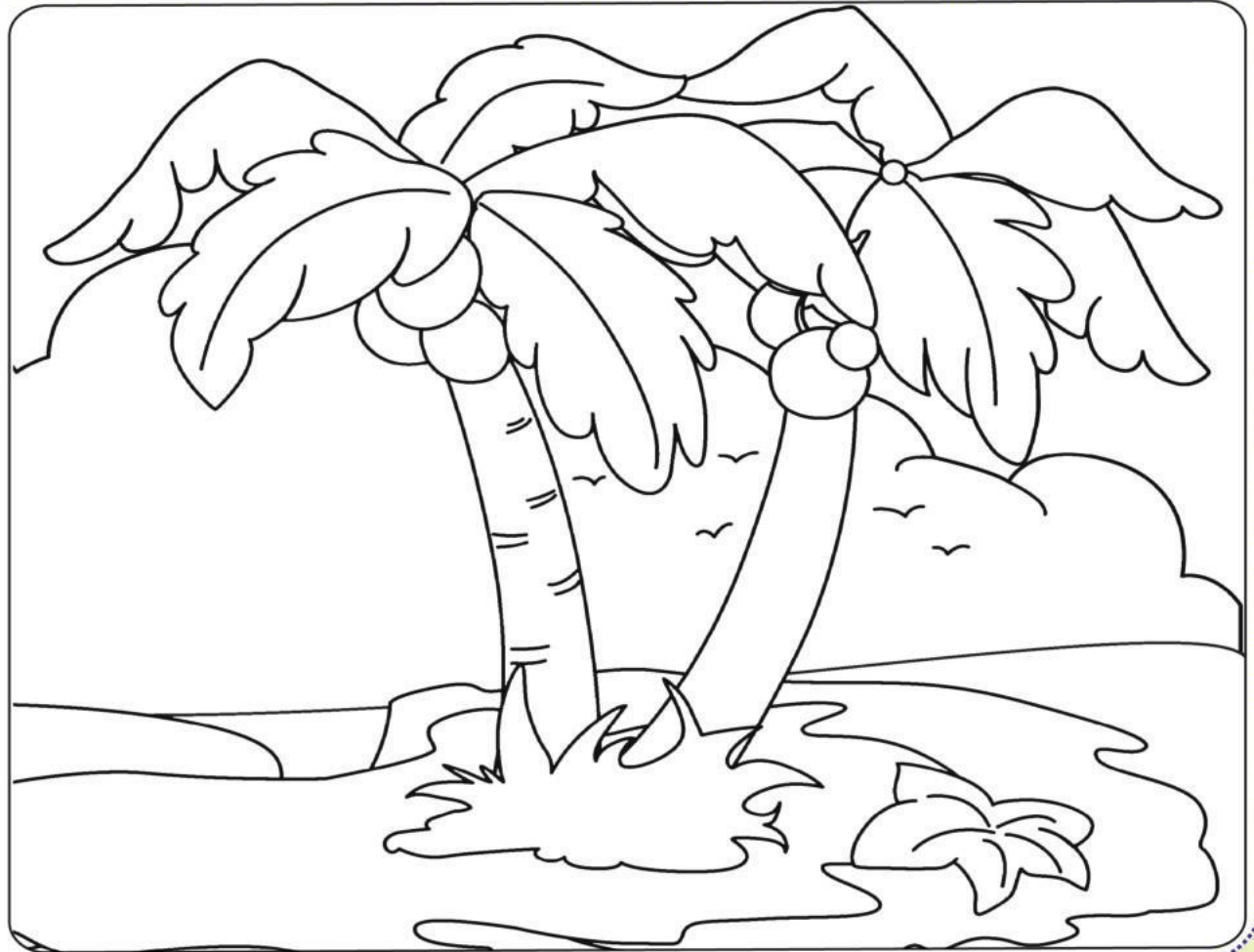
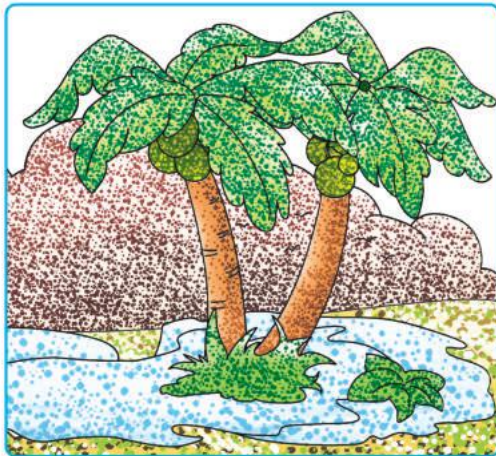
