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TYPES OF PENCIL SHADING

SOME PENCIL SHADING TECHNIQUES

Some important pencil shading techniques are mentioned here.

Repetition : By repeating our pencil strokes, we may get different types of patterns and textures. We divide this technique into three parts : (i) Etching (ii) Cross etching (iii) Scribbling

Etching :



Light etching



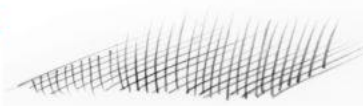
Dark etching



Darker etching

Small short strokes may be slanted, usually drawn in a downward direction. We may add more pressure and more repetition to get a dark shade.

Cross etching :



Cross etching is done by shading lines in such a way that all lines cross each other to create a darker shade and desired effect.

Scribbling :



Light scribbling



Medium scribbling



Dark scribbling

Scribbling is done by using the pressure on the pencil. We may give more pressure and repeat scribbling to get darker type of scribbling.

Smudging



A piece of cotton cloth or a piece of cotton is used for smudging. It makes our work much easier and less time consuming while shading big sketches and making even shading effects.

Step 3 : Now using the sketch pens make a face for the doll.



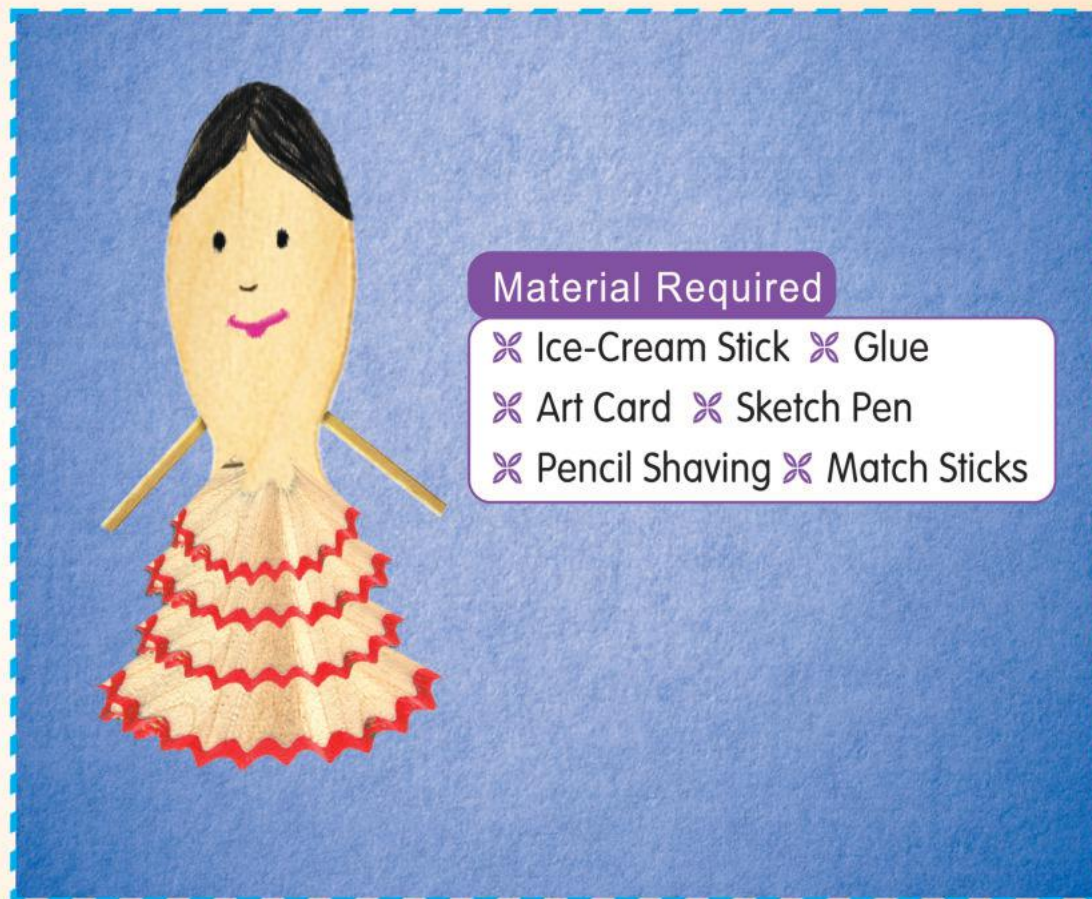
Step 4 : Shave the pencil to get pencil shavings.

PHOTO FRAME MAKING

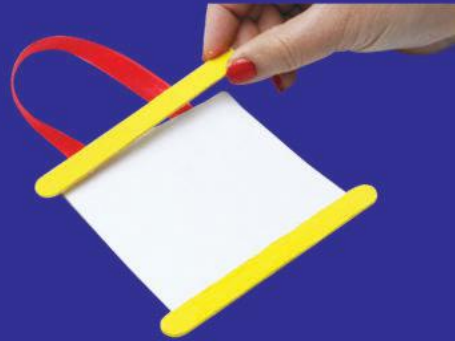
Step 1:

Now, Rocket is ready to fly.

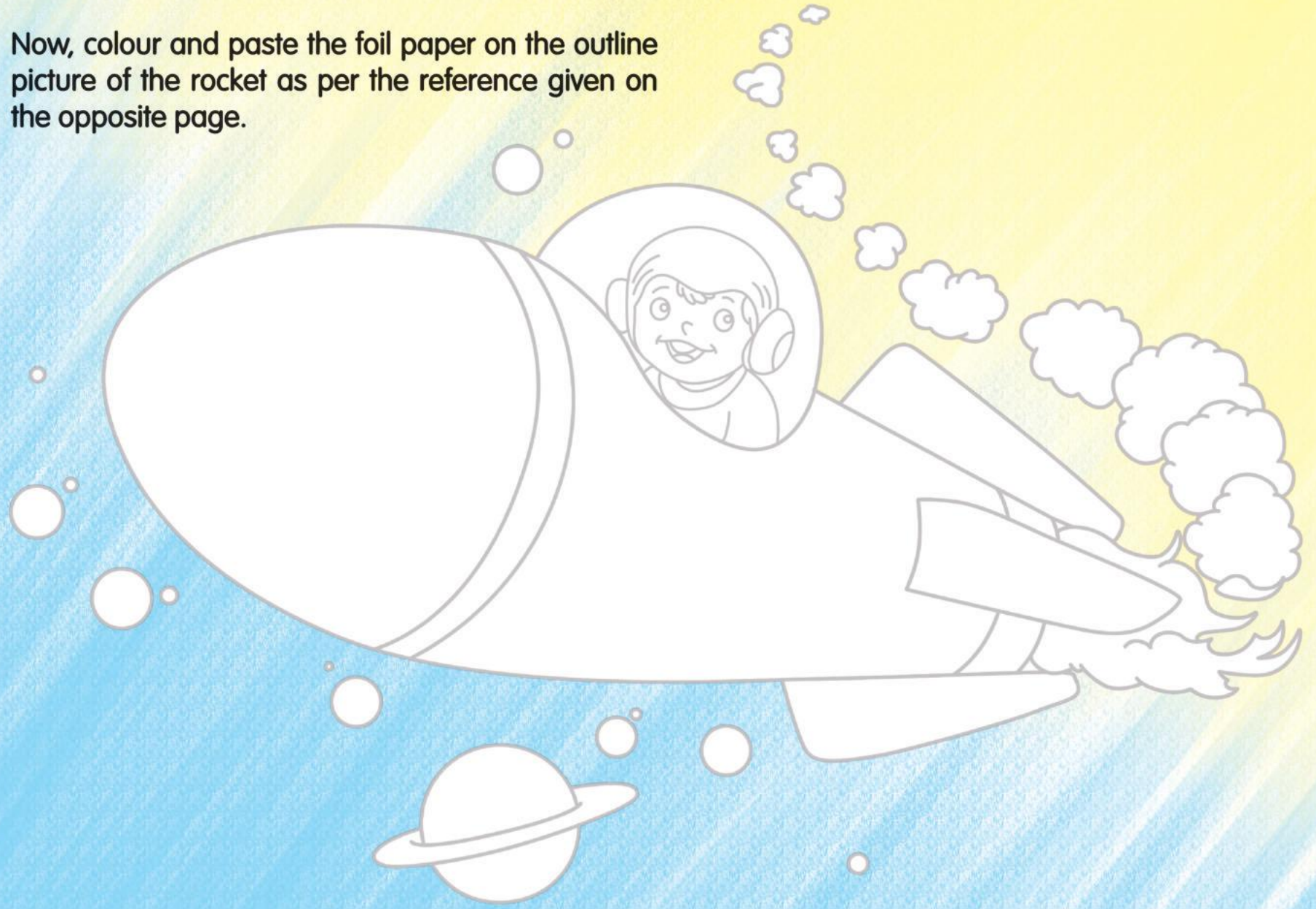
