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


















THERMOCOL BALLS AND PAPER PASTING

WET CHALK DRAWING

Step 1: Immerse the chalksticks in water (about 3/4th of the length of the chalk stick)



Step 2 : Leave to soak for 5-7 min. The chalk should stay in one piece.



Step 3: Remove them and lay then on a plate.



Step 4: Start drawing on your paper. The colours will appear richer and deeper than dry chalk.





Tip: You can dip the tip of your chalk in white paint. Then the drawing marks you. Make will show not only the colour of the chalk but also an edge of white paint.






COTTON BUD PAINTING

Step 2: Cut the handprint out and create a heart in the middle. Then take the contrasting cardstock green and fold it in half. Glue the


handprint on this sheet, keeping one edge folded to create the card. Cut the outline out so it frames the hand print but make sure to keep one edge folded.

Step 3 : Fold and unfold to make crease in the middle.




WAX COLOUR TECHNIQUE









CRAYON RESIST WATER PAINTING





6. Draw eyes and mouth with marker. Your's finger puppet is ready now.










THUMB IMPRESSION PAINTING

Make thumb impressions on the fins of the fish and also paste wool on the body and colour rest of the picture.










AIR BLOW TECHNIQUE


Blossom Tree



Your lady bird is ready.










RICE ART

Rainbow

Make the rainbow by using small pieces of rice.

Steps

- 1. Draw a rainbow on a thick sheet of paper.
- 2. Take rice and divide it into 7 parts. Using poster colours, colour the rice in different colours that a rainbow contains.
- 3. Spread fevicol on the areas you want to colour blue. Sprinkle blue rice on it. Gently pat to set it. Apply fevicol on the areas you want colour green. Sprinkle green rice on it.
- 4. Fill the remaining parts of the rainbow in the same manner.
- 5. No area should be left without rice on it.

Note: Let the painting dry up for sometime.
