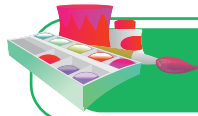

Steps

1. To make a bus, take a piece of each yellow, white, pink and black colour dough (fig 1).
2. Take the yellow colour dough and give it a shape of cuboid for the bus (fig 2).
Next, take the pink colour dough and flatten it with the chapati roller (fig 3).
3. For decorating the bus, cut two pink colour strips with the knife (fig 4).
Place the pink colour strips around the body of the bus aligning it with the bottom side (fig 5).
4. Take the white colour dough and cut it into strip with the knife (fig 6).



Materials Required

- Coloured Clay dough
- Chapati Roller
- ✂ Knife



5. Cut out two windshields for the front and back. Cut out eight small windows according to the size of the bus. Then, cut two headlights (fig 7).
6. Fix the big windshield and small windshield on front and back side of the bus. Place the eight windows on the left and right side as shown in the figure (fig 8).
7. Divide the black colour dough into four parts. Take the four parts and mould them into round shapes. Press them to make the tyres. Make four small round shapes for the wheels with the white colour dough and press them. Place the white round shapes in the centre of the black tyres as shown above (fig 9).
8. Join the wheels with the body of the bus as shown here (fig 10).
Your's school bus is ready.



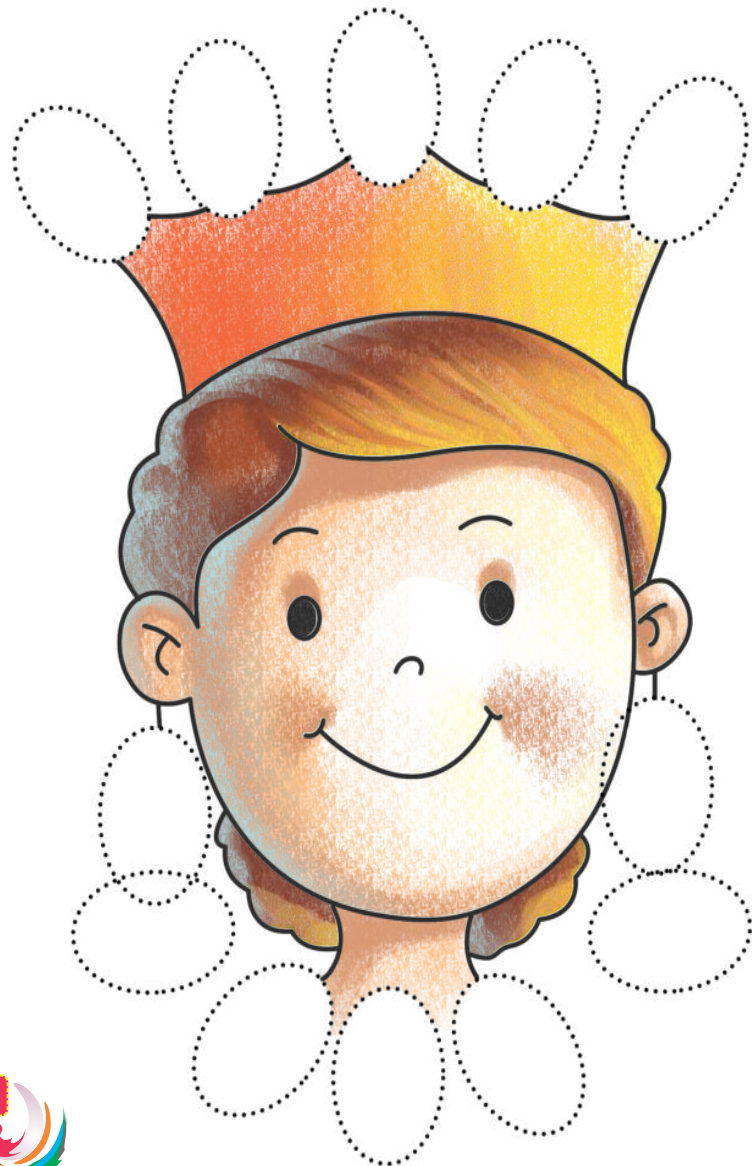

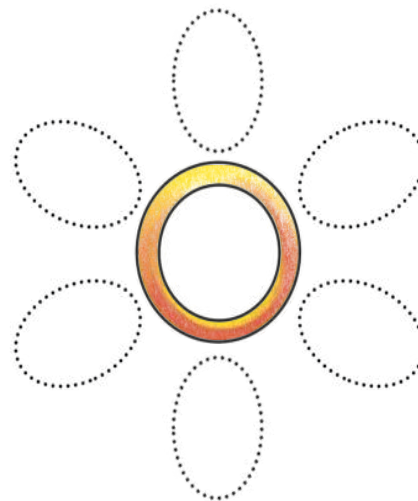
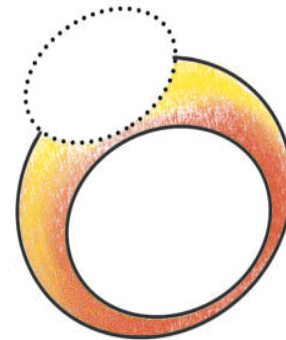
THUMB IMPRESSION PAINTING

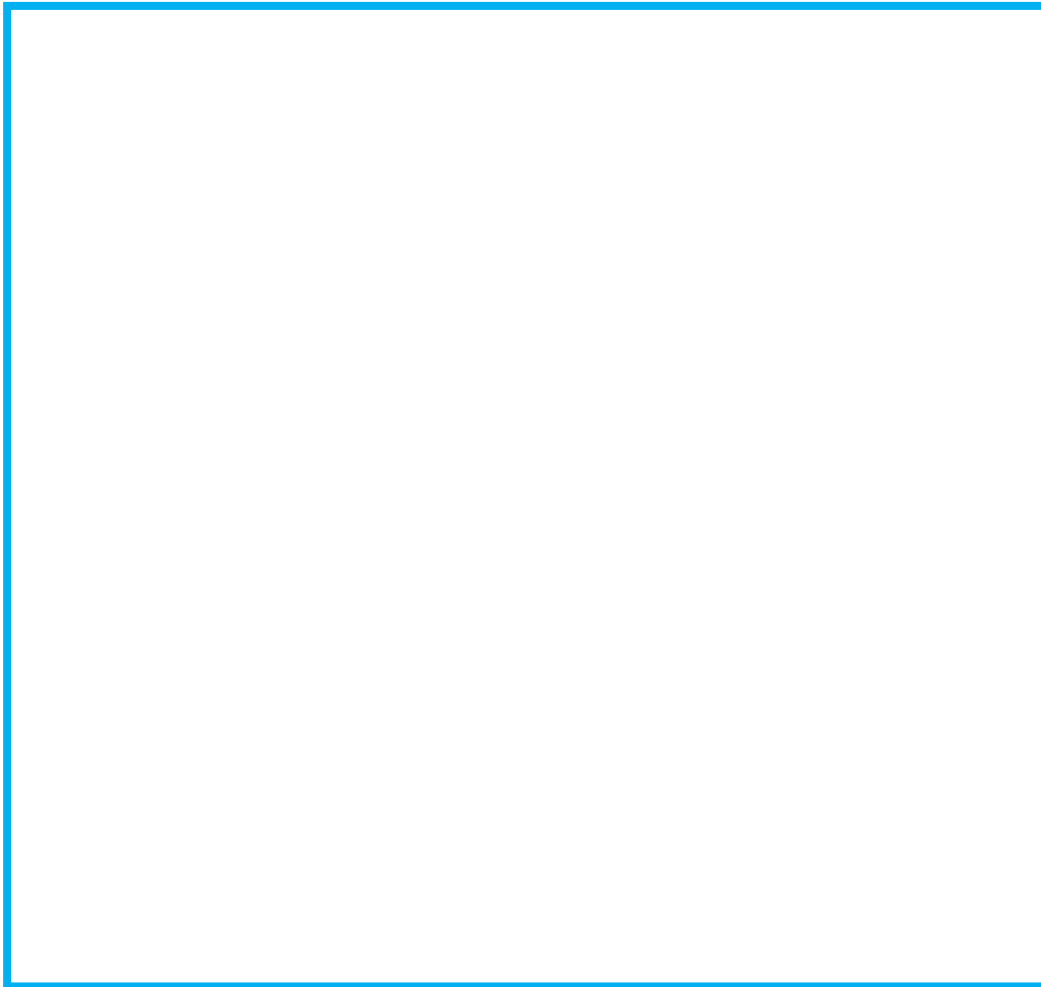




SALT WATER PAINTING

Step 1 : Draw lots of white, wavy lines on the space provided.



Step 2 : Paint a blue water colour wash over the sheet using any shades of blue.

Step 3 : Before your paint dries, sprinkle some salt over the paper. Really cool designs will appear in your paint, as it dries.



Step 4 : Now make some water animals on another sheet of paper using crayons.

Step 5 : Cut them out.

Step 6 : Glue them onto your salt ocean artwork and let it dry.



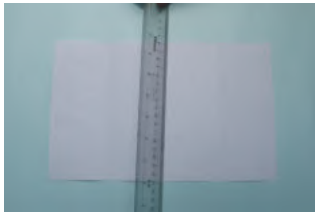

CARD MAKING

Father's Day

Step 1 : Take an A4 size sheet or card stock. Mark its middle section by lightly drawing a line with a pencil.



Step 2 : Fold both the sides of the sheet towards the middle. Overlap one flap slightly over the other.



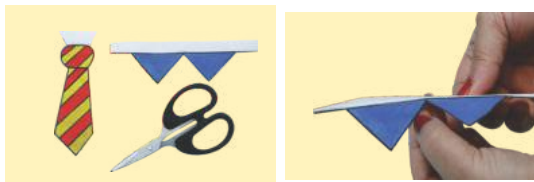
Step 3 : Colour or paint the two flaps using crayons or paints. Keep the inner side clean.



Step 4 : Take another sheet of paper and draw a neck tie and colour on it as shown. Colour the neck tie as you like. Don't colour the tabs.



Step 5 : Cut them out and crease the tab along its base on both the necktie and collar.



Step 6 : Position the necktie at the center of your greeting card. Glue the necktie top tab at the back of the greeting card. Similarly do for the collar as shown.



Step 7 : Lift the joined collar and necktie and write your message directly onto the center area of your greeting card.

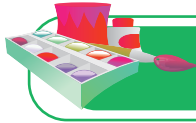


Step 8 : Close the front flaps of your greeting card and position the necktie on top.



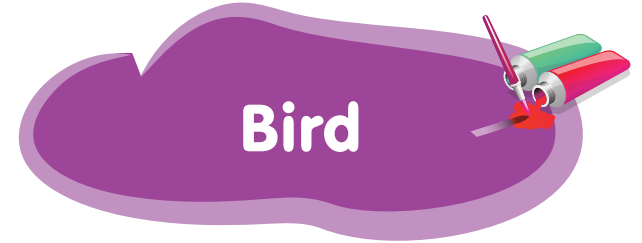

ICE-CREAM MATCHSTICK ART

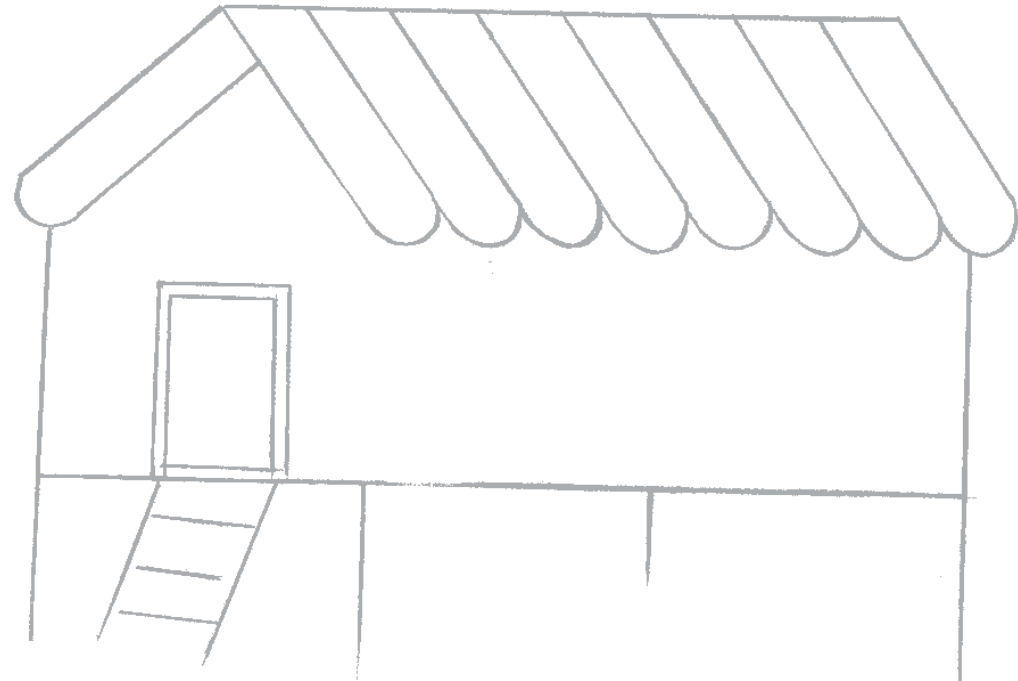

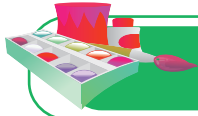

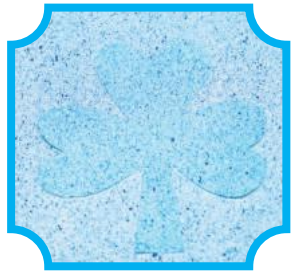


SPRAY PAINTING

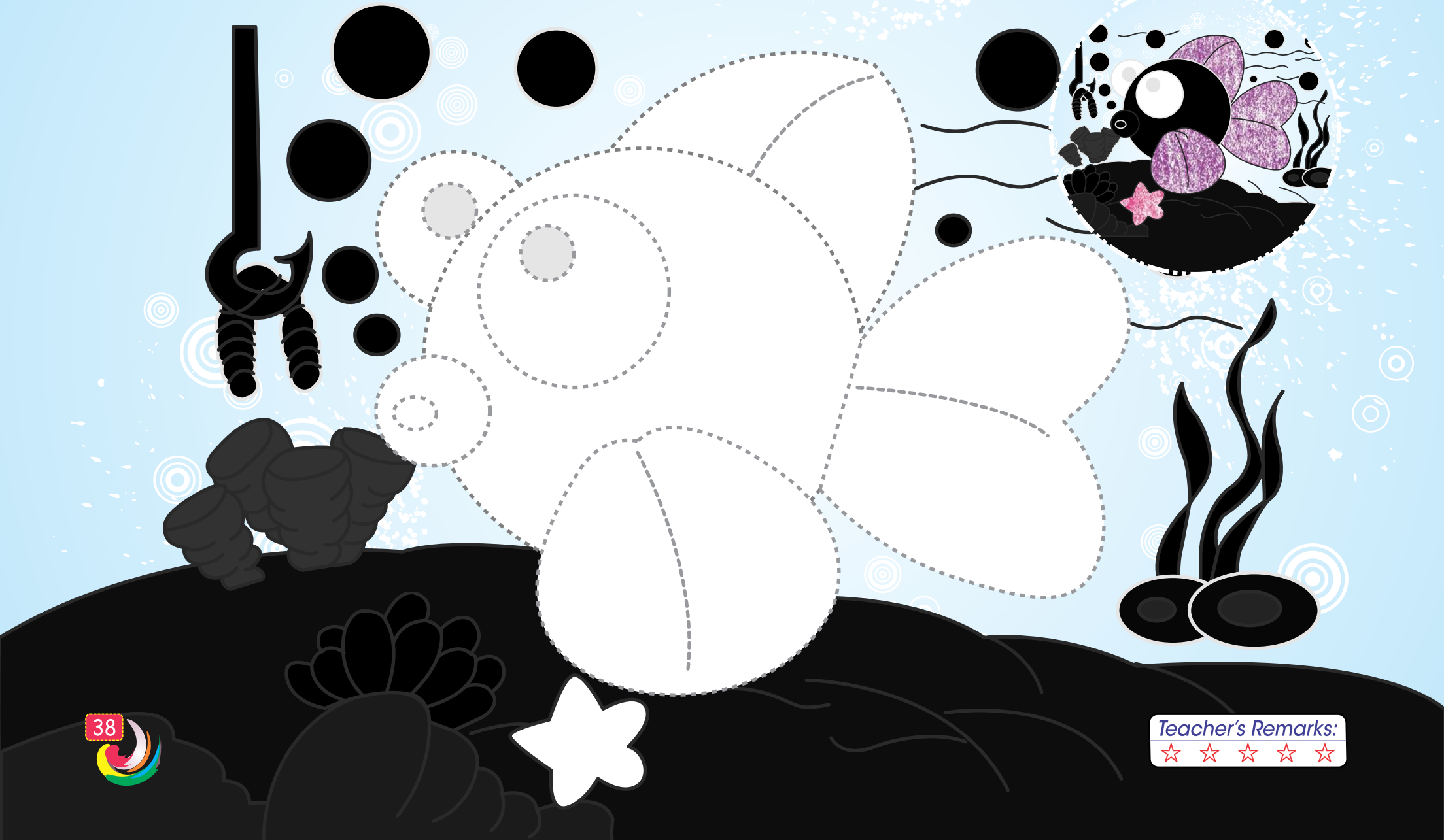

SCIENCE TRICK

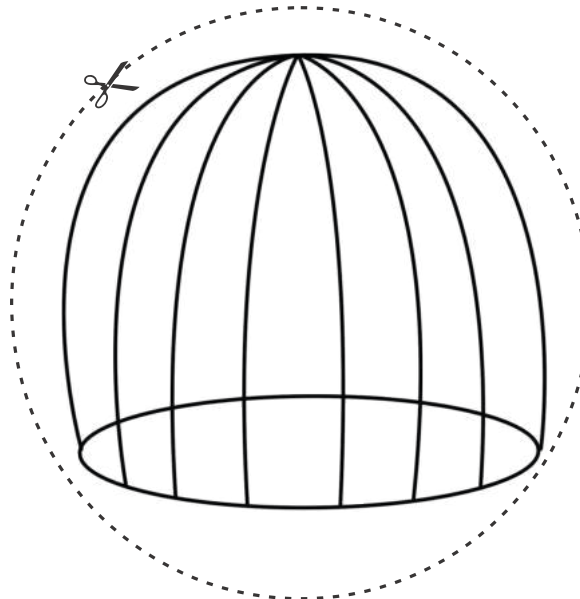
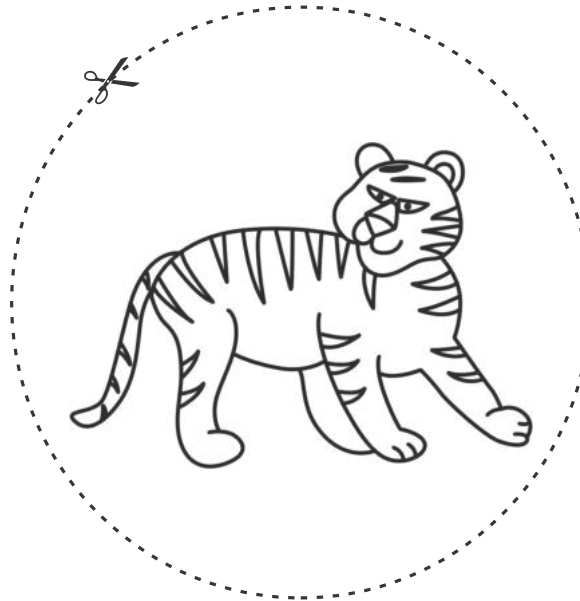


Cut the cage and the tiger along with the circles and colour the tiger.

Step 2 : Lay one picture face down and spread some glue on it, stick pencil. Stick the other picture on the other side of pencil facing opposite.

Step 3 : When the glue has dried, hold the pencil as shown. Rub your hands to make the pictures spin. The animal appears to be in the cage.



Vision mix

We see the animal appear in the cage because the pictures are moving too quickly for our eyes and brain to tell the difference between the two. Cartoons and movies use this effect by moving a series of still pictures very quickly. This creates an illusion of movement. You will learn more about this phenomenon in your higher classes.
